

EXHIBITING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR HARVEST DAY FAIR EXHIBIT

1. All exhibits must be registered for competition between 1 P.M and 5:00 P.M. on Friday, September 25, 2009 at the Pocahontas County Senior Center (across the street from Opera House).
2. All exhibits will be recorded and tagged by fair volunteers.
3. All departments are open to any adult or youth who desires to enter exhibits.
4. All baked goods must be exhibited on plain white paper plates in clear plastic bags. Following are recommendations:

Breads - ½ loaf	Cookies - 3
Muffins – 3	Candy – 4 pieces
Biscuits – 3	Cakes - 2 slices
Rolls - 3	Pies – 2 pieces

5. Fair committee cannot be liable or responsible for loss, theft, or casualty to exhibits entered.
6. Judging will take place from 9:00 A.M to 10:00 A.M on Saturday, September 26. The public will not be allowed in the Senior Center during judging.
7. Exhibits will be open for public viewing beginning at 10:30 A.M. on Saturday, September 26, 2009.
8. Exhibits MUST be picked up between 4:00 P. M. and 5:30 P.M. on Saturday, September 26, 2009.
