Please include your name and a brief description of your craft in the body of your email. As this is an arts/crafts show, we ask that products be handmade in nature. Selling items with reference to "Roadkill Cook-off" is not permitted. Once pictures are received and reviewed, you will receive an email regarding acceptance.

All applications must be postmarked by August 9, 2024. <u>Late entries will not be accepted.</u> Spaces are limited and will be assigned on a first-come, first-serve basis, with preference given to returning vendors from the prior year. We try our best to accommodate certain space requests, however we cannot guarantee requested spaces. **Electricity is not available, and generators are prohibited.**

## Autumn Harvest Festival & WV Roadkill Cook-off Vendor Application September 28, 2024 9:00 am - 5:00 pm Main Street and 3rd Avenue, Marlinton, WV

Vendor spaces are approximately 12'x12'. Vendor is responsible for tables, chairs, canopies, etc. **Electricity is not available and generators are prohibited for ALL vendors.** Setup up will begin on Saturday at 7:30 am. All vehicles must be out of the vendor area by 8:30 am. Registration fee is \$60.00 per space for crafters and \$30.00 per space for fundraising & information booths. Non-profit food vendors will pay \$45.00 per space and for profit food vendors will pay \$65.00 per space and are required to be current members of the Chamber of Commerce. Also, for profit food vendors must pay a seperate fee to the Pocahontas County Health Department. Registration for all vendors is on a first-come first-serve basis. Registration fees are non-refundable. Selling any items with referece to "Roadkill Cook-off" is not permitted.
